As a transgender person, I have often lived in fear of discrimination and even violence just for being who I am. However, people are gathering signatures to put Initiative 1552 which would rollback our state's 10 year anti-discrimination laws that protect transgender people like me from discrimination at work, school, and in places of business.

A 2010 [survey](#) found that 60% of transgender Washingtonians experienced harassment or disrespect in a place of public accommodation. So when Washington State enacted nondiscrimination protections for lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender people ten years ago, I was greatly relieved.

Being transgender is an important part of who I am, but it is not the only thing about me. I am also a parent, involved in my child's school, and work every day to make my community better.

That is why I am joining Washington Won't Discriminate, a broad coalition of faith leaders, businesses, law enforcement and other Washingtonians standing against Initiative 1552.
